

## RINGCENTRAL CLOUD PBX FOR MICROSOFT TEAMS: USER TIPS

### Using Active Call Controls

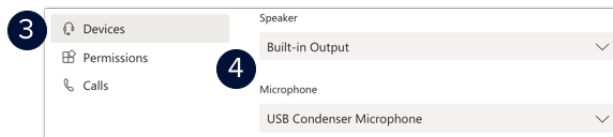
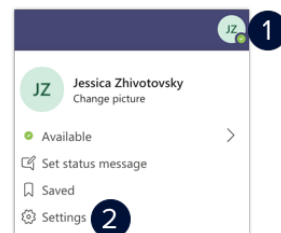
Dial these commands through the Microsoft Teams keypad during an active call to produce the corresponding actions:

Action	Key Code
Start / Stop Call Recording	*9
Transfer Call Internally	# # (Ext. Number) #
Transfer Call Externally	# # *1 + Phone Number
Park a Call	# # *3
Retrieve a Parked Call	* + (Park Location Ext.)

### Checking Audio Settings

Follow these steps to check your audio devices in the Microsoft Teams app:

1. Click your profile icon.
2. Click **Settings**.
3. Select **Devices**.
4. Ensure that the correct devices are selected under the **Speaker** and **Microphone** sections.



### Checking Voicemail

Check your voicemail messages using any of the following methods:

1. Access your RingCentral **My Extension portal** (<https://service.ringcentral.com>). Select **Messages** and click **Inbox**.
2. Dial **\*86** using the Microsoft Teams app keypad.
3. Open your RingCentral voicemail email notification and download the attached voicemail message. (This method requires the “email notifications for voicemail with attachment” setting.)

**Note:** Check with your account administrator for additional details about your extension’s voicemail settings and permissions.

### Recording Custom Voicemail Greetings

Follow these steps to record a custom voicemail greeting for your extension:

1. Access your RingCentral **My Extension portal** (<https://service.ringcentral.com>).
2. Click **Settings**.
3. Click **Messages**.
4. Select **User Hours** or **After Hours**, depending on where you prefer to record the custom voicemail greeting.
5. Click **Edit** under the Voicemail Greeting section.
6. Select **Custom** from the **Set Greeting** drop-down menu.
7. Choose one of the following options to record your custom voicemail greeting:
  - **Phone** – RingCentral will call you to record your custom greeting.
  - **Computer Microphone** – Press record and speak into your computer microphone.
  - **Importing** – Upload a .WAV or .MP3 file.
